Investigating the area

- Explore similarities and differences between localities and share ideas
- Locate the site in relation to other familiar places, plan routes; give directions; take photographs; draw maps
- Describe physical and human processes and how these have changed the site and the activities and lives of local people, and local productivity
- Recognise differing views held by people. Put forward own views. Use primary and secondary sources of evidence to back-up ideas.
